## Tuesday, April 23 – Brunswick, GA (B, L)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before we travel to Jekyll Island. Step into the past as we board a guided trolley tour of the 240 historic districts of the Island. The fascinating area where prominent American tycoons founded and created an exclusive gilded era island retreat on Georgia's coast. Following the tour, we head to St. Simon to spend the late morning on a shrimping boat, named the "Lady Jayne," where you'll learn about shrimping from an expert naturalist before enjoying a traditional shrimp boil lunch. Explore the lives of sea turtles and other native animals at the Georgia Sea Turtle Center, a rehabilitation, research, and educational facility that provides emergency care to sick and injured sea turtles. We will return to the hotel, where you will have the remainder of the evening at your leisure.

## Wednesday, April 24 - Savannah, GA (B, D)

After breakfast at the hotel, we bid farewell and travel to Savannah. We will meet our local guide, who will share the sights of the beautiful streets and squares of the city which is filled with exquisite iron work, ancient cobblestones, splendid mansions and picturesque cottages. You will have some free time to explore the new Plant Riverside District, a vibrant, riverfront entertainment destination that offers incredible dining and high-end shopping. After you have enjoyed a delicious lunch on your own, we will visit the Byrd Cookie Company Store. Be sure to save some room for samples of their famous cookies! We will head to our hotel to relax before we have an unforgettable experience at a Savannah Bananas baseball game. Referred to as the World-Famous Baseball Circus, the game of Banana Ball is not your typical game. Players perform choreographed dances, play in kilts and they have epic scoring celebrations. Get ready for a night of fun! Enjoy all you can eat hot dogs, hamburgers, chicken sandwiches and more. (Game subject to availability, schedule will be released in November 2023).

## Thursday, April 25 – Savannah & Charleston (B, L)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before we set out for another fun-filled day. Experience the history of where the Eighth Air Force was activated in January 1942 at the National Museum of the Mighty Eighth Air Force. Here you can see exhibits, interactive experiences, artifacts and a collection of aviation art. At the conclusion of the guided tour, you will have the chance to relax and enjoy a buffet luncheon. From gangsters to rumrunners, learn about the most infamous troublemakers of the 20's and 30's at the American Prohibition Museum, where you will learn to make your own hooch while exploring an extensive collection of moonshine stills.



## Friday, April 26 – Charleston, SC (B, L, D)

Breakfast will be enjoyed at the hotel before we board the motorcoach for Charleston. We will visit one of America's oldest working plantations, Boone Hall Plantation and Gardens, where we will witness the Gullah culture with a guided tour of the house and 9 original cabins. A southern style farm-to-table lunch will be enjoyed on the beautiful back lawn. After lunch we will tour America's only tea factory at the Charleston Tea Plantation. Tonight's farewell dinner will be served aboard the Spiritline Cruise Ship for a sunset cruise as we view the stunning sunset on the beautiful Charleston harbor.

## Saturday, April 27 - Home (B)
