TUESDAY, MAY 14 (B, L, D)

Today we begin our day touring the rural countryside and visiting an Amish farm. To give us an immersive experience, we will be doing this from the comfort of our own Amish buggy. Next up, we will visit an Amish homestead and one room school. Learning about how today's Lancaster Amish community live, we will watch a 5-screen special effect film called "Jacob's Choice." We'll even have the opportunity to shop the many amazing offerings at the Amish Store and enjoy an Amish farm lunch. Our last stop today is at the Sight and Sound Theater, where we'll see the brand new, original stage production of "Daniel."

WEDNESDAY, MAY 15 (B, L, D)

After breakfast at the hotel, we will view a 20-minute film about the Battle of Gettysburg, "A New Birth of Freedom," narrated by award winning actor Morgan Freeman, followed by the Cyclorama Painting, which is an oil painting that along with light and sound effects, immerses visitors in the fury of Pickett's Charge during the 3rd day of the Battle of Gettysburg. Your step-on guide will explain the various monuments and markers seen throughout the park. Lunch will be enjoyed at the historic Dobbin House Tavern. It was established in 1776 making it the oldest standing structure in the town limits. Later, a trolley tour of the town of Hershey will be filled with fun facts, laughter, history, and of course chocolate samples. Lastly, we included time for an opportunity to shop for some sweet treats! Dinner will be enjoyed with the group this evening.

THURSDAY MAY 16 (B, L, D)

The Antique Automobile Club of America (AACA) Museum is our first stop today. Located in beautiful Hershey, Pennsylvania, it ranks as one of the top automotive museums in the world. This mixture of permanent and changing exhibits highlights the evolution of transportation over the years. The Julius Sturgis Pretzel Bakery was the first commercial pretzel bakery in the United States. Enjoy a tour of the bakery and get a hands-on lesson in pretzel twisting! This stop wouldn't be complete without enjoying one ourselves! Next, continue to beautiful Kennett Square, where we'll learn how Pennsylvania got its title as the mushroom capital of the world. Here, we'll visit a store celebrating all things fungi. Our last stop of the day is at the breathtakingly beautiful Longwood Gardens. This botanical garden has more than 9,000 different varieties of plants covering over 1,000 acres.
