DAY 2: TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 17 (B, L, D)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before we head to the Creation Museum followed by the Ark Experience. Here we will “board” a full-scale replica of Noah’s Ark, which has three floors to explore. We will witness the Bible come to life while imagining what life would have been like living on the Ark. Spanning 510 feet long, 85 feet wide and 51 feet high, this modern engineering marvel amazes visitors young and old. Later this afternoon, we will enjoy a tour and barrel tasting at Whiskey Thief Distillery, followed by a BBQ dinner at the distillery.

DAY 3: WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 18 (B, D, L)

After enjoying our breakfast buffet at the hotel, we will meet our step-on guide and enjoy a riding tour of Historic Bardstown voted the “Most Beautiful Small Town in America” and the Bourbon Capitol of the World. The day’s activities include a visit to the Abbey of Our Lady of Gethsemani and the Log Still Distillery, where we will learn the history of this unique distillery. We will also visit the homestead that inspired Stephen Foster’s, “My Old Kentucky Home.” Tonight, we will enjoy dinner at the Old Talbott Tavern with free time on Fourth Street Live before we call it a night.



DAY 4: THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 19 (B, L, D)

After breakfast at the hotel, we begin our day with a tour of Louisville Slugger Museum. Later we will enjoy the Frazier Museum, learning about the early days of moonshine and how the bartender at the Louisville Pendennis Club claims have invented the famous Old Fashion (I think not). A trip to Kentucky wouldn’t be complete if we didn’t include a little “horse talk.” This afternoon we tour Church Hill Downs and learn about the horses and wagers, before enjoying a twilight race with dinner.

DAY 5: FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 20 (B, L)

This morning we enjoy our breakfast buffet before we begin to journey home.
