

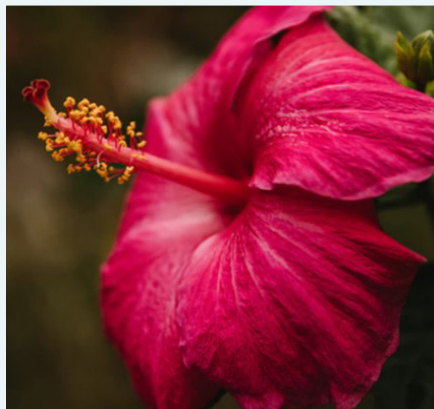

DAY 1: THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 15

HONOLULU, HAWAII

Fly to Honolulu, Hawaii on the island of Oahu and check into our ocean view rooms at the Hyatt Regency Waikiki Beach Resort & Spa for a two-night stay. Waikiki Beach, restaurants and shopping are just steps away from our resort!

DAY 2: FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16

OAHU, HAWAII

Depart this morning on a sightseeing tour of the east side of Oahu including Diamond Head, Halon Point/Blow Hole and the Pali Lookouts. We'll also drive through the hallowed grounds of the National Cemetery of the Pacific Punchbowl Crater. DAY 5: MONDAY, FEBRUARY 19

MAUI, HAWAII

Depart: 6:00 PM

Enjoy the sights along the famed Hana Highway, tour one of the historical plantations or join a certified marine naturalist and take to the water to search for humpback whales.

DAY 6: TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 20

HILO, HAWAII

Arrive: 8:00 AM, Depart: 6:00 PM

Our private Hilo Volcano excursion will include visits to Lili'uokalani Garden, the largest such garden outside of Japan, and Big Island Candies, home to the world-renowned Chocolate Dipped Macadamia Nut Shortbread Cookie. We'll stop at Richardson's Black Sand Beach, one of the few black sand beaches on the island, for a spectacular view of Mauna Kea. Rainbow Falls State Park is home to a breathtaking waterfall and spectacular rainbows. We'll visit Volcanoes National Park where you will find lava fields, Kilauea Iki Overlook, dormant craters and steam vents.

DAY 7: WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 21

KONA, HAWAII

Arrive: 7:00 AM, Depart: 5:30 PM

Kona offers the quintessential Hawaiian experience. Sunny, warm weather and crystal blue waters entice visitors to partake in a variety





of surfside fun, which you can arrange to do on your own. Snorkel amongst a kaleidoscope of tropical marine life. Take a surfing lesson, a kayaking trip or head out to deeper waters for some deep sea fishing. Visit a local coffee house to taste the famed Kona coffee. Enjoy views of beautiful Kealahou Bay, or make a stop at St. Benedict's historic painted church, noted for its colorful murals depicting biblical scenes.

DAY 8: THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 22

KAUAI, HAWAII

Arrive: 8:00 AM, Ship Docked Overnight

Today's exclusive excursion starts with a leisurely drive through quaint Koloa Town to the Spouting Horn, where ocean water erupts through underground lava tubes. See the 3,600-foot deep Waimea Canyon. Formed by the Waimea River, the canyon is a grandiose array of red, brown and green hues, complemented by sparkling waterfalls. Take in the view at the Opaekaa Falls Lookout and venture into the Fern Grotto, a natural lava-rock grotto covered with hanging ferns and tropical foliage. Then, relax on a tranquil Wailua River cruise surrounded by lush tropical landscapes.

DAY 9: FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 23

KAUAI, HAWAII

Depart: 2:00 PM

Spend the remainder of your stay as you choose in Kauai with an exciting journey back to Waimea Canyon or visit the rugged Nā Pali Coast by helicopter, catamaran or kayak on the Waialua River to Fern Grotto.

DAY 10: SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 24

HONOLULU, HAWAII

Arrive: 7:00 AM

After disembarking the ship this morning, we will visit the Dole Plantation. Ride on the Pineapple Express Train and have time to explore the Plantation Garden. Afterwards we'll visit the Polynesian Cultural Center. Travel through time and space to experience thousands of years worth of culture from six different island nations, each with its own flavor and appeal. After our visit we will transfer to the airport for our overnight flight home.

DAY 11: SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 25

Arrive home. "A hui hou kākou Hawaii" (Until we meet again Hawaii).
