
ROCKS ROCKIES TO RED

DAY 1: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 5

Meals: Dinner

Upon our arrival in Denver, we will check into the hotel for one night and enjoy a group dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 2: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 6

GLENWOOD SPRINGS, CO

DENVER, CO

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Early this morning we will transfer to Denver's Union Station to experience Rocky Mountaineer's newest rail journey, Rockies to Red Rocks! Breakfast and lunch are served on the train. On our all-daylight rail tour, we'll witness extraordinary landscapes including vast canyons, natural archways and enchanting hoodoos. Today we cross the Continental Divide while cutting through 6.3 miles of the Moffat Tunnel, an engineering marvel. Later, our course follows the Colorado River through rugged Glenwood Canyon, before arriving in Glenwood Springs. We will stay overnight at a Glenwood Springs hotel.

DAY 3: MONDAY, OCTOBER 7

MOAB, UT

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

It's "all aboard" this morning at the Glenwood Springs Train Station for our second day on the Rocky Mountaineer as we continue our journey west. Breakfast is served on board. We will cross the Colorado-Utah border with stunning mountain views in the background. Gorgeous red sandstone landscapes emerge as we approach Moab. Explore charming downtown Moab this afternoon with its plentiful dining options and myriad of shops. Later, we will check into the Hampton Inn Moab for the night. Tonight, we'll enjoy dinner at Zax's.

DAY 4: TUESDAY, OCTOBER 8

MONUMENT VALLEY, AZ

Meals: Breakfast, Boxed Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast at the hotel we'll make our way to our put-in spot for a raft trip on the Colorado River. Our adventure will take us from the epic vistas of red sandstone monuments and mesas into magnificent canyons with 320 million years of geologic history. Afterward, we will depart Moab and head south into the desert-west landscapes of Arizona. We'll drive by iconic Monument Valley with its fragile pinnacles surrounded by miles of mesas and buttes. Later tonight we will arrive at Glen Canyon National Recreation Area, the official name for Lake Powell, and check into the Lake Powell Resort & Marina for the night. We'll enjoy dinner at the resort, complete with panoramic lake views.


DAY 5: WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 9

GRAND CANYON

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

A delicious breakfast buffet is included at the hotel this morning before we head out on our boat cruise. This cruise will provide us with an up-close opportunity to view the colorful and sculpted geology of the lower end of Lake Powell. This high-walled Navajo Sandstone side-arm of Lake Powell is famous for not only its coloration, but also for its famous slot canyons. We'll also cruise near the Glen Canyon Dam, the second largest concrete arch dam in the United States. After our cruise we leave Lake Powell and make our way to one of the Seven Natural wonders of the World, the Grand Canyon!







Upon arrival at Grand Canyon National Park we'll make a couple photo stops before checking into our accommodations in Grand Canyon Village at Yavapai Lodge for one night. Our lodge is located only a half mile from the rim and along the free Village Shuttle Bus route. The evening is yours to spend as you wish; stroll along the Rim Trail, soaking in the amazing views, stop by the Visitor's Center to explore exhibits about the history and geology of the park or shop for souvenirs in one of the many gift shops. You'll have a voucher to enjoy dinner at our lodge at your leisure.

DAY 6: THURSDAY, OCTOBER 10

SEDONA, AZ

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

After breakfast a local guide will board our coach and share with us information on the history, geology, flora and fauna of the park. We will stop several times to enjoy incredible vistas of the canyon. After, we will depart and head south to Sedona. We'll drive through scenic Oak Creek Canyon as we approach Sedona. Situated amidst gorgeous, towering red-hued rocks, you will soon understand why it has been recognized as America's most beautiful western town. After free time to explore, shop and enjoy lunch, we will take off on a jeep tour for some of the most iconic Sedona views. Later, we check in for two nights at the Poco Diablo Resort. Take time to relax before we depart for a delicious dinner at a local favorite, lavelina Cantina.

DAY 7: FRIDAY, OCTOBER 11

IEROME, AZ

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

This morning we travel to Jerome, "America's Most Vertical City" and "Largest Ghost Town in America." Enjoy the history, shopping and views in this very unique town. This afternoon, we'll take a four-hour scenic train ride aboard the Verde Canyon Railroad. You will receive a voucher to use for lunch at the café before boarding. The passenger coaches and open-air viewing cars pulled by vintage locomotives will offer you expansive views of the remote wilderness of the Verde Canyon. This area is renowned for its towering pinnacles and clean, green waters. The train rolls past Native American ruins, through a 680-foot man-made tunnel, over old-fashioned trestles and under clear azure skies. The picturesque views are further enhanced by a variety of indigenous flora and fauna, including many migrating waterfowl.

This evening, when the dinner bell rings at the Blazin' M Ranch you will be treated to a chuck wagon supper served on a tin plate by cowpokes. After supper, sit back and enjoy the harmonic sounds of the famous Blazin' M Cowboys, who will entertain you with their hour-long Western stage production that includes delightful cowboy music, storytelling, comedy, and some surprises you won't want to miss.

DAY 8: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 12

PHOENIX, AZ

Meals: Breakfast

After breakfast, it's time for us to head to the Phoenix Airport for our return flight, taking with us fond memories of our time touring the Rockies to the Red Rocks!


