Day 1 - Monday, April 4:

Our flight aboard Frontier Airlines departs this morning from Milwaukee to Los Angeles International Airport, where you will be met by our local tour director. Enroute we will enjoy a delicious lunch before we transfer to the **Palm Springs Hilton**, for a four-night stay in the heart of downtown Palm Springs. You will be pleased to see that the hotel is ideally located within easy walking distance of a wide variety of shopping, dining and entertainment. A **“welcome” dinner at Johnny Costa Ristorante** will begin our tour with a bang.

Day 2 - Tuesday, April 5:

After breakfast, a day of great sightseeing begins with a fascinating **guided tour** of exclusive Palm Springs and the Coachella Valley, including the homes of the stars, fabulous desert resort hotels, some of the area’s more than 100 golf courses and handsome date-palm-lined boulevards. Would you like to dine like a celebrity? We will have **lunch at Elvis Presley’s home... poolside!** Then have an afternoon visit to the amazing **Palm Springs Air Museum** which houses one of the nation’s largest collection of World War II aircraft displayed in modern, well-lit, air-conditioned and clean hangars. This evening we will enjoy dinner at **Old Creek House** followed by a spectacular performance from the **Palm Springs Follies**-a world-famous, Broadway-caliber celebration of the music, dance and comedy of the 40s, 50s and 60s with a cast old enough to have lived it! Day 3 - Wednesday, April 6:
